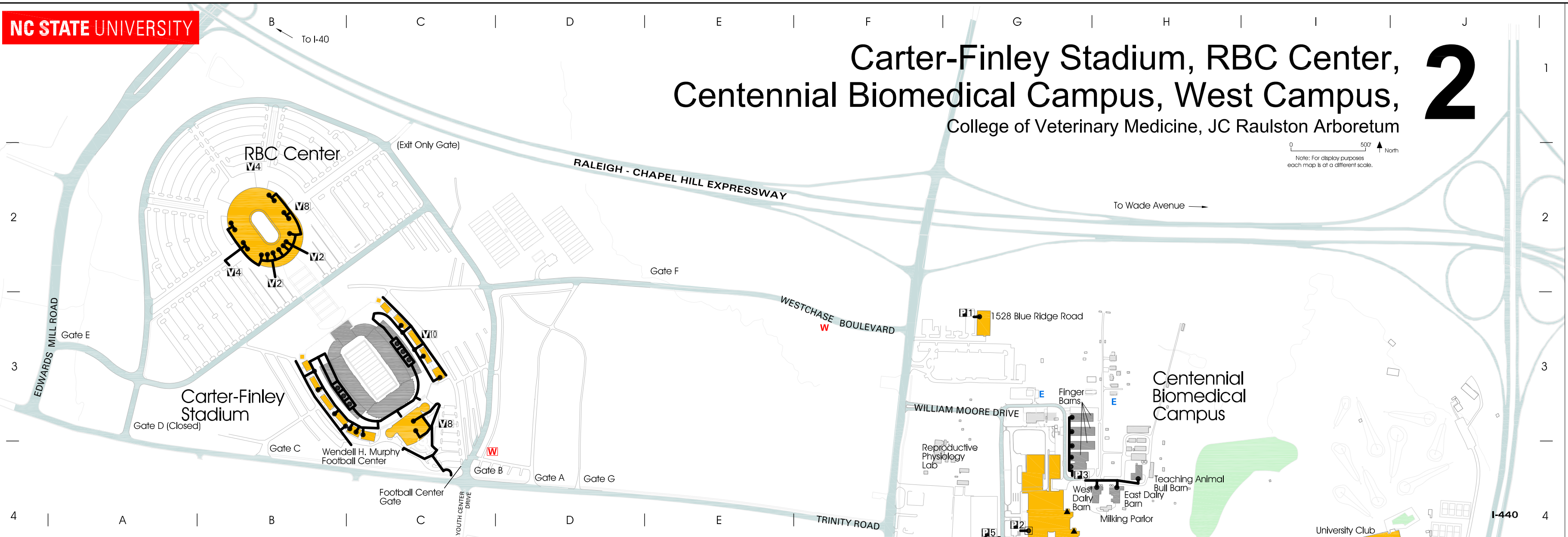
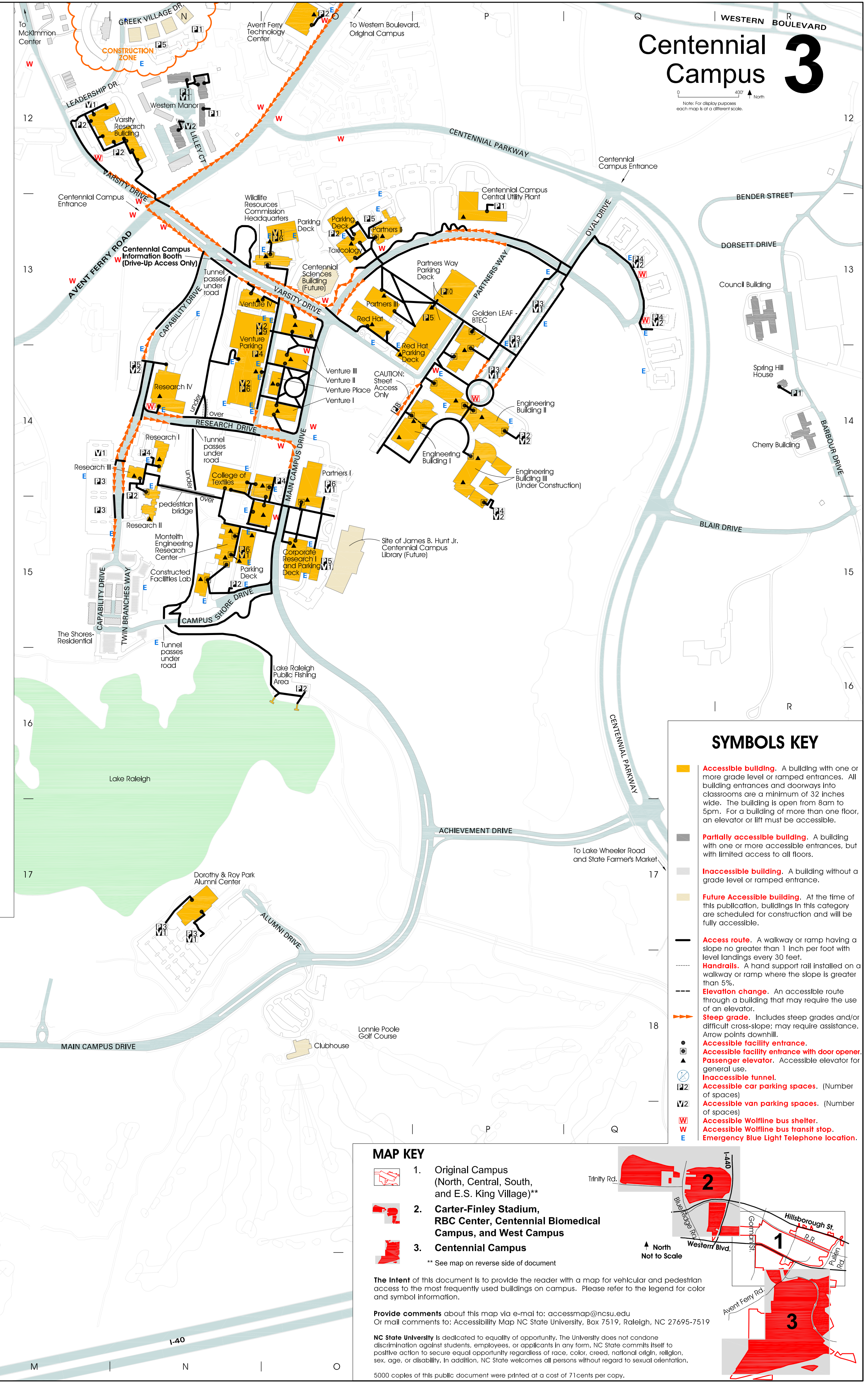

SYMBOLS KEY

- Accessible building.** A building with one or more grade level or ramped entrances. All building entrances and doorways into classrooms are a minimum of 32 inches wide. The building is open from 8am to 5pm. For a building of more than one floor, an elevator or lift must be accessible.
- Partially accessible building.** A building with one or more accessible entrances, but with limited access to all floors.
- Inaccessible building.** A building without a grade level or ramped entrance.
- Future Accessible building.** At the time of this publication, buildings in this category are scheduled for construction and will be fully accessible.
- Access route.** A walkway or ramp having a slope no greater than 1 inch per foot with level landings every 30 feet.
- Handrails.** A hand support rail installed on a walkway or ramp where the slope is greater than 5%.
- Elevation change.** An accessible route through a building that may require the use of an elevator.
- Steep grade.** Includes steep grades and/or difficult cross-slopes; may require assistance.
- Anchor points downmill.**
- Accessible facility entrance.**
- Accessible facility entrance with door opener.**
- Passenger elevator.** Accessible elevator for general use.
- Inaccessible tunnel.**
- Accessible car parking spaces.** (Number of spaces)
- Accessible van parking spaces.** (Number of spaces)
- Accessible walkway bus shelter.**
- Accessible walkway bus stop.**
- Emergency Blue Light Telephone location.**
