Issues of odors, re-entrainment, insufficient supply air, insufficient exhaust, and balancing exist in the building. This project will consist of multiple phases and continue as funding to support a complete renovation becomes available.</p> <p>Phase 1 (advanced planning study) will complete an engineering evaluation and condition assessment of the current life safety and HVAC systems. Recommendations for corrective measures will support existing programmed space while planning for future programmed space changes.</p> <p>Phase 2 (design and construction) will complete renovations allowed by available funding and support upcoming critical program additions identified by the Chemistry Department. | <p>Dearstyne HVAC Renovations Project Number: 201611034</p> <p>Items in Review Package: ✓ Drawings ✓ Specifications</p> <p>Scope of Project: The Dearstyne Avian, Dearstyne Isolation, and Dearstyne Entomology facilities (Dearstyne Complex) at NC State consist of 15,772 GSF and includes a combination of labs, isolation spaces, and offices for the Department of Poultry Science. The single-story buildings are currently served by an HVAC system consisting of hot water boilers, air-cooled chillers, and multiple Air Handling Units. The Dearstyne Complex HVAC renovation project will include new air handlers, building wide HVAC controls upgrade, demolition of penthouse mechanical spaces, and miscellaneous mechanical equipment/component replacements to meet the conditions required by space utilization.
