Item 1) The draft of the "Process for Removal of Heritage Trees" was briefly discussed. TS recommended that the draft and comments received be sent to the committee to review. This draft will be discussed at the next meeting and if there is consensus, will be adopted. TS suggested that MD and EI recommend how best to communicate with the community when the decision has been made to remove a Heritage Tree.

2) MD and others questioned whether or not the efforts begun following the December 15, 2016 meeting to review the health of all trees currently on the list were technically a full assessment. MW stated that the intent was a visual inspection of the trees, not a full assessment. Following the meeting, MD confirmed that the International Society of Arborists categorizes tree risk assessments into three levels. The assessments made by the working group are "Level 1: Limited Visual Assessment." It was proposed that the visual assessments occur annually, and more thorough evaluations occur every 5 years.

3) It was mentioned that Grounds Management received \$22,000 of funding towards Heritage Tree maintenance in fiscal year 2016-2017.
